Our Industry

- The red meat and livestock industry contributes approximately \$7 billion to Australia's gross domestic product
- The industry is Australia's largest food manufacturer and a significant employer in rural and regional areas, directly employing some 200,000 Australians on-farm, in meat processing and at wholesale / retail plus thousands more indirectly
- The Australian red meat production sector has custody over roughly half of Australia's land mass
- The Australian red meat processing sector has an annual turnover in excess of
 \$20 billion ranking it as the largest trade-exposed manufacturing industry in Australia
- We produce around 3% of the world's beef, 5% of the world's sheepmeat and
 0.5% of global goatmeat production
- By value, we are the world's largest exporter of beef, sheepmeat and goatmeat
- By number, we are the world's largest exporter of livestock
- In 2015, approximately 70% of Australian beef production, 56% of lamb and 95% of mutton production, as well as 1.9 million live sheep and 1.3 million live cattle were destined for international customers
